RED WINE

1. Ginestet St. Emilion, Château Perey - Bordeaux

Deep garnet in appearance, this wine has a rich, intense nose that leads into a palate that is balanced and well rounded with plenty of dark berry fruits and subtle, well integrated tannins. £31.95

2. Fleurie La Chapelle de Bois – Beaujolais

The most popular of the Beaujolais Crus, this attractive ruby coloured wine has soft berry fruit and floral aromas on the nose and a rich palate showing redcurrant fruit character. £31.95

3. Châteauneuf du Pape Galets Roules - Rhone

Delicious, warm, rich, fruit flavours typical of Grenache and Chateauneuf. Excellent quality with soft supple tannins. Very good wine from a specialist Chateauneuf producer. Drinking well now. £39.50

4. Amerone Classico del Fondatore – Italy

Very complex with developed warmth, spice and rich berry fruit flavours on the palate and finishing with a distinctive bitter tang. £42.00

5. Marqués de Cáceres Reserva – Rioja, Spain

Deep ruby red in appearance, the bouquet is elegant with rich cherry and raspberry fruit aromas and a touch of fine oak. The palate is full and fleshy with well balanced, delicious red fruit character and velvety, soft, ripe tannins. £35.50

6. Prahova Valley Pinot Noir – Romania

Vibrant ruby appearance with aromas of black cherry and vanilla on the nose. The palate is fruity and well balanced with good length of flavour. **£14.95**

7. Hidden Rock Petit Verdot/Cabernet Sauvignon – Australia

A full flavoured blend of 80% Petit Verdot and 20% Cabernet Sauvignon. Petit Verdot is a rare grape variety normally found in classic Bordeaux red wines, adding colour and richness. This wine has a good deep colour and ripe flavor of raspberries and blackcurrants. It has firm, smooth tannins and good length of flavour. Great with rich food and more character than the average Shiraz/Cabernet blend. **£15.95**

8. Ocean Point Shiraz – Australia

Produced from grapes harvested largely in Goulburn Valley and Swan Hill. This wine is vibrant and fruity with good palate structure and depth. It has aromas of raspberry and cherry with underlying spices and an integrated oak finish. The oak used is French, which gives the wine added complexity. **£16.95**

9. Lutzville Pinotage – South Africa

A new grape founded in 1926, from Hermitage and Pinot Noir grapes. Deep plum in colour with raspberry overtones. **£19.95**

10. Orchid Boulevard Merlot – California

Soft black cherry aroma with a touch of green olives and rhubarb. The flavour has smooth berry fruit character and soft tannins. Easy drinking. **£17.50**

11. Concha y Toro Merlot – Chile

Unoaked and bursting with red and black berry fruits, soft and warm on the palate and medium bodied with balanced length. **£22.00**

12. Olive Hills Pinot Grigio Pink – Italy

Light rose colour. Delicate fresh fruit character with nice mineral notes.

Reasonably dry in style and very refreshing. £18.95

13. Marqués de Cáceres Rosado – Rioja, Spain

Vivid pale raspberry in appearance with an impressive, intense bouquet of strawberries, raspberries and redcurrants.

Deliciously rich in the mouth with fleshy fruit flavours that are full and luscious. A lively, fresh and elegant wine with balanced acidity. £23.95

14. La Umbra Merlot Rosé by Prahova Valley – Romania

Soft fruity easy drinking rose with attractive raspberry fruit character.

Very quaffable easy drinking style. £14.95

15. Orchid Boulevard White Zinfandel Rose – California

Attractive salmon pink colour. Pleasant floral bouquet with soft fruit characters.

Medium sweet taste with nice strawberry fruit flavours and balancing acidity. £17.50

16. Concha y Toro Merlot Rosé – Chile

A beautiful salmon pink wine with intense, fruity aromas on the nose.

The palate is fresh, crisp and youthful with an abundance of ripe strawberry fruit flavours and a smooth, balanced finish. £22.50

17. Chabis La Colombe – Chablis

Delicious example of this classic dry white. Very good concentration and balance with minerally character and good length. £31.50

18. Chablis 1er Cru Vaucopins Chateau de Viviers – Chablis

2005/06

A dry, crisp, elegant Chablis with developing Chardonnay character of tropical fruits and a soft, rounded finish. £42.00

19. Sancerre Domaine Moulin Granger – Loire

Classic Sancerre style, more herbaceous and grassy than gooseberry with lovely mineral flavours. Well balanced with a nice length of flavor. £34.00

20. Piesporter Michelsberg QbA Schmitt Sohne – Germany

A light, elegant wine from the Mosel Valley with delicate floral aromas, nicely rounded with crisp, fruity flavours on the palate. £20.50

21. Olive Hills Pinot Grigio – Italy

Pale yellow colour. Attractive citrus fruit character on the nose and palate. Easy drinking Pinot Grigio with good balance and ripe fruit flavours. Good aperitif wine or would drink well with creamy pasta dishes. £18.95

22. Prahova Valley Pinot Grigio – Romania

Attractive pale yellow colour. Soft, rounded fragrant bouquet. The taste is medium dry with good fruit and low acidity. Easy drinking and good for aperitif or bbq. £14.95

WHITE WINE

23. Hidden Rock Colombard/ Verdelho – Australia

A delicious blend of Colombard (65%) and Verdelho (35%). The grapes are harvested at night to preserve freshness prior to fermentation. Verdelho adds a ripe citrus/grapefruit character to the wine, making it stand out from the usual Semillon/Chardonnay blends. It has a pale lemon colour, good citrus and tropical fruit flavours and good weight. £15.95

24. Ocean Point Chardonnay – Australia

This wine is a blend of cool climate regions specializing in Chardonnay production. This wine is unoaked and has light tropical fruit flavours and a nice clean finish. £16.95

25. Babich Sauvignon Blanc – Marlborough, New Zealand

Pale lemon gold in appearance with a clean, fresh varietal fruit nose. The palate is medium in body with crisp, refreshing gooseberry fruit character and a hint of herbaceousness. A lovely wine with fineness on the finish. £25.95

26. Lutzville Chenin Blanc – South Africa

Soft, fruity Chenin with nice balance of guava fruit character and balancing acidity. From the Olifants River region in the Western Cape. £19.95

27. Orchid Boulevard Sauvignon Blanc – California

Easy drinking Sauvignon from the Lodi region in California. Softer and rounder in style than Chilean or French Sauvignon with citrus fruit character rather than gooseberry or asparagus. £17.50.

28. Concha y Toro Sauvignon Blanc – Chile

Excellent Sauvignon fruit character and a grassy aroma delivering a mouthful of fruit combined with balanced acidity and along finish. £22.50

29. Concha y Toro – Chile

Late Harvest Sauvignon Blanc 37.5cl

Brilliant golden yellow in appearance with bright, amber notes.

*The nose is full of ripe papaya and peach with underlying honeyed characteristics. The palate is luscious but fruity with good balancing, refreshing acidity that carries through on the long finish. **£18.50***

SPARKLING WINE

30. Ackerman Saumur Brut Rosé 1811 – Loire

A refreshing, sparkling rose wine made in the Loire Valley.

*Deep salmon pink in colour with a freshly scented nose and red berry fruit character on the palate leading to a smooth finish with a lasting a sparkle. **£26.50***

31. Prosecco Verduzzo Spumante – Italy

Light, refreshing sparkling wine from Northern Italy.

Made from the Prosecco grape the flavor is fragrant and delicate with soft fruit flavours of apples and white peaches.

*Perfect as an aperitif. **£25.50***

Dry with an attractive fruity and easy drinking character.

33. Mercier Brut NV

Light refreshing style of Champagne, very popular in France.

34. Mercier Brut Rose NV

Light elegant Champagne with good fruit and balance.

Perfect aperitif. £49.95

35. Mœt et Chandon Brut Imperial NV

Pale gold in colour with creamy, biscuit aromas, good depth and concentration, lively but with a soft, dry finish. £59.00

36. Veuve Clicquot Yellow Labell Brut NV

Elegant golden with a deep bistuity nose. A wine with plenty of fruit, dry with fine balance and style. Presented in the distinctive yellow labeled bottle. £65.00

37. Laurent Perrier Cuvée Rosé NV

A delicate rose, light and refreshing with flowery, fragrant character and hints of summer fruits on both the nose and palate. Perfect for any romantic occasion. £76.00

38. Dom Pérignon Vintage 2000

One of the Champagne's most outstanding wines. Refined with a palate showing layers of yeasty, nutty flavours.

39. Beaujolais Cave de Bel-Air – Burgundy

Bright ruby in appearance, delighted and fresh, this is a well made wine full of juicy Gamay fruit flavours. £14.50

ROSE

40. Marqués de Cáceres Rosado – Rioja, Spain

An intense bouquet of strawberries, raspberries and redcurrants. Fleshy fruit flavours, lively, fresh and elegant with balanced acidity. £14.50

WHITE

41. Chablis Château de Viviers - Chablis

An excellent mouthfilling Chablis with enough fruit to balance the clean, steely dryness that is typical of this wine. £16.50

CHAMPAGNE

42. Mœt et Chandon Brut Impérial

Pale gold in colour with creamy, biscuit aromas, good depth and concentration, lively but with a soft, dry finish. £29.95

43. Veuve Clicquot Demi-Sec

Rich and intense on the nose with a sweet yet refreshing palate and soft, smooth finish. £34.50
